

Instructions for Contributors

International journal of pharmacy research is an online international journal that aims to promote the exchange of original knowledge and research in any area of pharmacy and to disseminate information and ideas that may help to cover research studies/reviews related to Pharmacy subjects including some of the allied subjects. Articles with timely interest and newer research concepts will be given more preference.

Authors must accept full responsibility for the contents and opinions expressed in the manuscript.

All manuscript submitted to the journal will be peer-reviewed. Editor will decide on whether the manuscript should be: accepted, accepted after minor revisions, accepted after major revisions or rejected. The final decision to accept or reject a manuscript will be taken by the editor.

Submission of Manuscript

All contributions must be submitted in English and follow the specific submission requirement stated below.

Manuscripts should be submitted electronically to editor@medlinepress.com

Manuscripts must be submitted by one of the authors of the manuscript, and should not be submitted by anyone on their behalf. The submitting author takes responsibility for the article during submission and peer review.

Each submission must be accompanied by a cover letter stating that the paper contains original research and that the information has not been published elsewhere.

Any manuscript submitted to the journal must not already have been published in another journal or be under consideration by any other journal.

The minimum requirements for a manuscript to qualify for peer review are that it has been prepared by strictly following the format and style of the journal as mentioned below, and should meet the International journal of pharmacy research standard. Submission may, however, be returned without review if, in the opinion of the editor, is inappropriate for the journal, is of poor quality or fails to follow the journal's format/ style.

Manuscript preparation

File Formats: Submit word files with tables electronically embedded within the text of the document with at least 2.54 cm margins on all sides. Photos and graphs should be uploaded in images option.

Manuscript Title: Top of paper, Times New Roman; Fonts all caps, bold, 14 points.

Author Names: Last name, followed full first name, corresponding author of the manuscript must be marked with an asterisk and should be listed first, font: bold, 12 points

Institution Name: Institution addresses 12 points.

E-mail: Email of corresponding author, 10 points.

First page file should contain Manuscript Title, Authors detail, Affiliation, Email, Address for correspondence and Acknowledgements (if applicable).

Article file should contain Abstract, Introduction, Materials and Methods, Results, Discussion or Results and Discussion, References; Tables should be appropriately included in the text.

References: The references should be listed on a separate sheet and should be numbered consecutively in the order in which they are cited in the text. Cite in the text by the appropriate arabic number e.g. 1, 2, 3 and the numbers should be superscripted within square brackets i.e. [1].
